

# VOLLEYS' RULES SHEETS

## DOUBLES

### 2017 SEASON

- 1<sup>st</sup> Team listed will serve 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> games. RALLY SCORING TO 21. Change sides at multiples of 7 points. You must win by two points with a **23 point cap**. If time is call, the team ahead wins the game.

- Each team will play 3 games – no matter who wins the first two. Standings will be based on the number of games won by each team. The team with the most wins will be league champion. In case of ties, there will be a one game playoff the last night of league play. You must play the final night in order to win the league (even though you may have enough wins without play).

#### **REMEMBER – POSITION NIGHT IS NOT WINNER TAKES ALL.**

- *VOLLEYS WILL NEVER CANCEL A LEAGUE-WE WILL PLAY RAIN OR SHINE.* If two teams agree to postpone, it is their responsibility to schedule a makeup before the last week of that session. Any games not made up will **not** be counted as wins for either team.

- All scores must be turned in the Saturday before position night in order to count for position night.

- First game will be a forfeit if 10 minutes late to court, 2 games after 15 minutes and 3 games after 20 minutes.

- A block counts as a hit but the same person may make the next hit which would be the 2<sup>nd</sup> hit.

- A power player may not sub on an intermediate team.

- No new subs on position nights. All subs should be on your roster.

- No open handed dinks or tips over the net.

- No sets over the net. Cannot receive serve with a set.

- The ball may be played with any part of the body.

- You may not block or spike the serve.

- **Any contact with the net during play results in a side out or point for the other team.** A player may cross under the net as long as they do not interfere with the other team's opportunity to play the ball.

- All other USAVB rules apply.

## 4-PLAYER

### THE ABOVE RULES APPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Team listed will serve 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> games. RALLY SCORING TO 25. You must win by two points with a **27 point cap**. If time is call, the team ahead wins the game.

- A block in not considered a hit.

- **"LET SERVE" is allowed.**

- **PLAYERS CAN "SET" THE SERVE.**

# VOLLEYS' RULES SHEET

## COED 6'S 2017 SEASON

- 1<sup>st</sup> Team listed will serve 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> games. RALLY SCORING TO 25. You must win by two points with a **27 point cap**. If time is call, the team ahead wins the game.
- Each team will play 3 games – no matter who wins the first two. Standings will be based on the number of games won by each team. The team with the most wins will be league champion. You must play the final night in order to win the league (even though you may have enough wins without play). In case of ties, there will be a one game playoff the last night of league play to 15. All teams are responsible in reporting the game results.
- *VOLLEYS WILL NEVER CANCEL A LEAGUE. WE WILL PLAY RAIN OR SHINE.* If two teams agree to postpone, it is their responsibility to schedule a makeup before the last week of that session. Any games not made up will **not** be counted as wins for either team.
- First game will be a forfeit if 10 minutes late to court, 2 games after 15 minutes and 3 games after 20 minutes.
- You may play with a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6. There does not have to be equal number of men or women on a team; however, at no time, can there be more than 3 men on the court.
- No more than 2 spectators may sub on one team at a time. These subs should be at the same level as the other team members. **POWER/INTERMEDIATE PLAYERS MAY NOT SUB ON REC TEAM. VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL BE A FORFEIT. A TEAM MAY NOT HAVE NEW PLAYERS/SUBS THE LAST NIGHT OF LEAGUE.** All subs should be added to your roster. If your sub is not on the roster, they cannot play.
- **Any contact with the net during play results in a side out or point for the other team. This applies to both recreational and intermediate teams. Please call your own violations.**
- A player may cross under the net as long as they do not interfere with the other team's opportunity to play the ball.
- Back row players may not attack or block the ball within 10 feet of the net.
- You may not block or spike the serve. The ball may be played with any part of the body.
- "LET SERVE" is allowed.
- If you have a disagreement about a call–replay the point. Coordinator has the final say in disagreements or rule interpretations. All other general volleyball rules apply.

### INTERMEDIATE RULES

**You may set the serve.** Underhand hits must be closed hand/fist or bumped.

### RECREATIONAL RULES

You may set the serve. Underhand hits can be open-handed as long as the ball is not caught or thrown.
